

Walk Details:-Walks in this programme will commence @ 10:00 unless otherwise stated, when the start time will be shown in BOLD print. Please check programme.

BRISK walks will maintain this pace throughout the walk; members who feel they would be unable to keep up are advised not to attempt them.

Food & drink - members should bring sufficient for their own needs over the length of the walk Please observe both the Highway Code on roads & the Country Code on all our walks.

Weather - If the weather is particularly bad prior to a walk we recommend that you contact the leader(s) before setting out, to check that the walk will still take place.

Dogs - are welcome on most walks but should be on a lead. Some walks are by permission of the landowner when only assistance dogs are permitted. If in doubt, please contact the walk leader.

Ordnance Survey (OS) Map References & Postcodes

The six digit number is the walk start location reference, with the first three digits showing position on the map edge scales horizontally & the second three showing position vertically. Postcodes shown should get you to the vicinity of the start point if using a Satnav but will not necessarily take you to the start point.

WALK BOOKS:- We have a wide range of books available to walkers, covering areas local to King's Lynn, as well as other parts of Norfolk. They all feature 16 circular walks with maps and are easy for the casual walker to follow.


